The Work2It Project focuses on the rehabilitation of young men who have been designated by the Youth Justice System as high-risk offenders. It is funded by the MB4Youth Branch of Children and Youth Opportunities of the Provincial Government of Manitoba.

### Target Group:

- Young men ages 15-24
- Designated high-risk offenders
- Multiple barriers to school or employment

### Objective:

- Improve life and pre-employment skills
- Enhance prosocial life style and thinking
- Attach to school or the labour force
